



Zakynthos route (2 weeks)

Saturday **Arrival Sivota**

Sivota is a beautiful bay that offers a safe haven for our fleet and along the marina of Sivota are a number of lovely fish tavernas and restaurants. Our jetty is managed by Theo, the owner of the 12 Gods restaurant. 12 Gods is where we hold our briefings and joint dinners.

Sunday **Sivota Lefkas - Vasiliki, Lefkas**

Vasiliki is the surf paradise of Lefkas. There is regularly more wind in this large bay which makes sailing here so popular. The marina is surrounded by the village and numerous (traditional) restaurants.

Monday **Vasiliki, Lefkas - Eufemia, Kefalonia**

Eufemia is a small holiday town with a lovely marina and boulevard. Here you will find various cafes, bars, fish tavernas, and restaurants. The village is built against the slopes of the surrounding lush green hills.

Tuesday **Eufemia, Kefalonia - Poros, Kefalonia**

Poros can be found in the southwest of the island of Kefalonia. There is always a lot of life at the marina due to the many ferries. The walk to the village is lovely along a broad boulevard with on the one side the beach and the other restaurants, shops, and bars.

Wednesday **Poros, Kefalonia – Zakynthos City, Zakynthos**

Zakynthos city is the capital of the island Zakynthos which was almost completely ruined in 1953 by a severe earthquake. Zakynthos city has approximately 12,000 inhabitants and is a modern city with many buildings in a classical style. There are streets with vaulted arches, churches with imposing bell towers, beautiful squares, and important monuments. The marina of Zakynthos is also located in this city.

Thursday **Zakynthos City, Zakynthos – Katakolon, Peleponissos**

Katakolon consists of three streets with various (fish) restaurants with terraces on the water. Katakolon is the 'gateway' to the famous Olympia, where the Olympic Games were organized centuries before Christ.

Friday **Katakolon, Peleponissos**

Today we stay in Katakolon. We can organize an outing to Olympia for those who wish. Or you could stay in Katakolon and enjoy the extensive beach or sailing (after consultation).



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Saturday **Katakolon, Peleponissos - Keri Bay, Zakynthos**

Keri Bay is a beautiful bay that has a sand-pebble beach. It is near Turtle Island where there are also several diving schools. There are also many hotels and tavernas where you can eat well and enjoy the fantastic view of the bay.

Sunday **Keri Bay, Zakynthos**

Today we rest. This is time for relaxing, diving, snorkelling, or sailing. The program is completely free, so do what you like!

Monday **Keri Bay, Zakynthos – Agios Nikolaos, Zakynthos**

The village of Agios Nikolaos itself is not that big and is scattered in the bowl-shaped bay. The fishing marina is located on the north side of Agios Nikolaos. From a quieter place, the terrace of the taverna (which is directly on the sea) you have a wonderful overview of the fishing marina and the bustle of the daily excursions in the distance.

Tuesday **Blue Caves tour and Anti-Sami Bay, Ithaca**

In the morning, for those who wish, we organize an excursion to the Blue Caves, then we sail to the Anti-Sami Bay on the island of Kefalonia. This bay is surrounded by green mountains and on the white pebble beach are several beach bars. Various water sport activities are also available here.

Wednesday **Anti-Sami Bay, Ithaca - Fiskardo, Kefalonia**

Fiskardo is a friendly fishing village in the north of the island of Kefalonia. It is a picturesque, colourful marina where many sailing yachts dock. There are many shops, terraces, and restaurants in the marina. The village is the only one to survive the earthquake of 1953. The traditional Venetian buildings are still intact and give the village a unique charm.

Thursday **Fiskardo, Kefalonia – Karnayo, Meganissi**

Meganissi is a small (20 km²) island southeast of Lefkas. Karnayo Bay lies immediately to starboard. A small family taverna with private beach and jetty where we will be docked with mooring lines.

Friday **Karnayo, Meganissi – Sivota, Lefkas**

Back to home base. Where you can refuel at the jetty before (unfortunately) the suitcase has to be packed. In the evening you can enjoy a delicious dinner at restaurant 12 Gods.

NOTE: Weather permitting you can drop anchor in various bays if you wish. The route can change from autumn and spring due to weather conditions and possible opportunities in particular marinas. These routes are example routes!
