Zaterdag Aankomst Sivota, Lefkas

Saturday: Arrival Sivota, Lefkada

Sivota is a beautiful bay and provides a safe shelter for our fleet. Along the small port of Sivota are a number of nice fish taverns and restaurants. Our jetty is managed by Theo, owner of the restaurant 12 Gods. This restaurant is also the base for our briefings and joint dinners

Sunday: Lefkada Town,

Lefkada Town, also called Lefkas town, is a cozy town. Terraces of restaurants and fish taverns are plentiful and the locally made dishes are very good. On the west side of the harbor you will find bars with terraces on the water and on the east side are mostly restaurants and cafes.

Monday: Parga, mainland

Parga is recognizable by the fortress 'Kastelli' in the hills and the long sandy beach. Here you can swim and / or paddle. In the evening we are taken by taxi-boat to the cozy center of Parga to wander in the many streets that Parga has to offer and dinner.

Tuesday: BBQ bay, mainland

A beautiful sandy beach on the mainland, where in the evening a BBQ is organized especially for the flotilla. Before that time you can swim, but there are also various water sports and activities offered.

Wednesday: Corfu Town, Corfu

At the foot of the fortress is Mandraki, a small "club" port. Here we are on mooringline and from here it is a small walk to Corfu Town. The beautiful fortresses, the Venetian-style houses, the impressive squares, the narrow alleys and cozy terraces ensure that it is a city that makes a great impression.

Thursday: Agni bay, Corfu

The picturesque Agni bay lies at the foot of the Pantocrator, the highest mountain on the island of Corfu. In this bay you can swim and snorkel and then go to the table tired in the evening, but satisfied.

Friday: Erikoussa, island north of Corfu

Erikoussa is the northernmost Greek island in the Ionian Sea. The island is located about 6 miles northwest of Corfu and belongs together with the islets of Othoni and Manthraki to the Diapondia archipelago. The island has 7 small villages, but the most important places on the island are Porto and Erikoussa on the east coast of the island.

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Saturday: Othoni, island north of Corfu

West of the island of Corfu lies the tiny Greek island of Othoni. This is the westernmost island of the Diapondia archipelago. The island is only 11 km2 in size and there are no more than 600 inhabitants who live off of fishing and olive cultivation. On the island you will find only 1 hotel, some B&Bs, a handful of taverns and a few shops. Furthermore, the island consists of only olive trees and rocks, a few Byzantine churches, an old lighthouse and some hidden and partly abandoned mini villages in the hills. Not really ingredients for tourism. And that is exactly what you will not find there. However, you will find peace and authenticity! And a lot of beautiful blue water on which you can sail fantasticly!

Saturday: Othoni, island north of Corfu (rest day)

Monday: Lakka, Paxos

The village of Lakka is located on the north side of the island of Paxos on a beautiful and well-sheltered bay. The bay is famous for its clear blue water. The charming village consists of narrow alleys that open onto squares. From the harbor you can take a beautiful walk up to the entrance of the bay and the lighthouse. There you have a wonderful view over the bay and the sea.

Tuesday: Mongonissi, Paxos

Mongonissi is located south of Paxos, only 4 kilometers away from the capital Gaios. What makes this small island so unique is the complexity of the landscape. In addition, the deep blue sea, the sandy beach and the impressive caves form an ideal landscape. We continue our sailing journey at Mongonissi Beach Bar. Their motto is: 'We serve you as we would serve our friends'.

Wednesday: Preveza, mainland

Preveza is located at the beginning of the Amvrakikos Kolpos. A beautiful 'inland lake' that is rich in fish. The lively village has a pleasant boulevard with several restaurants and bars. But above all, take a side street and you will discover all small alleys to walk around.

Thursday: Karnayo, Meganissi

With the flotilla we are at tavern Karnayo, just outside the small town of (small) Vathi on the island of Meganissi. From here it is about a 10 minute walk to the village. At the tavern itself there are shower facilities and a small supermarket. Fresh bread can also be delivered. A wonderful place to swim from the small pebble beach.

Friday: Sivota, Lefkada

Back to home base. Where you can refuel at the jetty before (unfortunately) the suitcases have to be packed. In the evening you can have a delicious dinner at the restaurant 12 Gods.
